

**AURORA UNIVERSITY AFTER-SCHOOL READING PROGRAM—Fall 2009**

Dear parents / guardians,

Aurora University will again be offering supplemental reading services for students in first grade through high school who may be experiencing reading difficulties. The students will receive individual assessment and tutoring at the Reading Clinic located on the AU campus in the Institute for Collaboration Building. The tutoring will be provided by certified teachers enrolled in Aurora’s Master of Arts in Reading Instruction (MARI) program who are fulfilling their teaching requirement for the degree and for Reading Specialist certification. Sessions will be scheduled on Tuesdays from 4:45 – 5:45 p.m. or 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. beginning September 1 and ending mid-December. **Parents will be required to provide transportation and ensure weekly attendance. Student absenteeism will result in removal from the program.** There is no charge for the program.

In order to register your son/daughter, please **complete this form** and return it along with a **copy of the student’s school records containing test results (ISAT, STAR, AIMSweb, ITBS)**. Openings are available for 20 students this session. Students registered for the tutoring will receive a follow-up letter with more specific information.
