It's not too late to file an application for fall admission to Aurora University. Applying on line is free and easy. Just go to:

In order to complete your application you will need to make sure to submit official transcripts from all prior college coursework. Upon applying, you will be assigned an Aurora University admission representative that will work with you throughout the admission process. If you have specific questions, please call 630.844.5533.

Make sure to list Aurora University on your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). It is important to file for financial aid as soon as possible, even if you are not yet admitted. [Our school code is 001634.](#)

Financial Aid, Filing the FAFSA and more....

Financial Aid packaging is well underway at Aurora University. Typically, we quote a two week turn around time from the day you submit your FAFSA (Free Application For

Federal Student Aid) to the day you receive your financial aid package. You will submit your FAFSA electronically at:

Each year you are enrolled in school, it is important for you to fill out this form. Make sure you have Aurora University's institutional FAFSA code: 001634

The FAFSA is used to determine if you are eligible for any state or federal grants. It is also needed to be awarded any type of student loans. Lastly, the FAFSA will determine if you qualify for Federal Work Study ---dollars allocated to holding an on-campus job.

This year, Aurora University is going GREEN. This means all required documentation, upon receiving a financial aid package, will require you to upload/print/complete/return forms. Should you have further questions on what you need to return to the university, please call our Financial Aid Office at: 630.844.6431. The link to print necessary forms is located at:

Upon receipt of your Financial Aid package, you should have a clear picture of what your out-of-pocket expenses will look like. Once you figure out what your balance will be, you will need to consider your payment options ---to learn more about Aurora University payment options go to:

Out of pocket expenses you should plan for:

Student Activity Fee \$100/year

Books \$1000/ year (est.)

Parking Permit \$25/semester

Student accident/sickness insurance \$234/semester (unless proof of alternative coverage is provided)...
