

IM COED 6 ON 6 SOCCER RULES

INTRAMURAL CONDUCT CODE

All players should display sportsmanlike conduct at all times. Remember that intramurals is provided to have fun, so please keep this in mind. However, in the event of any unsportsmanlike conduct these guidelines will be followed:

First warning Any individual who exhibits unsportsmanlike conduct, such as rough play, obnoxious behavior, excessive profanity, or any other behavior that inhibits orderly play will receive a first warning.

Final warning Any individual who repeats the conduct listed above will no longer be able to play for the remainder of the game

All warnings will be recorded, and reported. If a player has had two final warnings throughout round robin play, they will be excluded from the tournament.

Guidelines

There will be two 10 minute halves played, with a 3 minute half time in between. The clock will run continuously except during the last minute of the half when it will stop with the stoppage of play. If a tie game ensues, 5 minutes of overtime will be played. If teams are still tied then sudden death play will determine the winner.

Any penalties given at the end of the half will be honored.

Each team will receive one time out per half. Time outs are one minute each.

There must be a minimum of 4 players to start a game at the scheduled time or else the team will receive a forfeit. Any team that forfeits 2 games will be dropped from the schedule.

A coin toss or some variation will determine team possession at the beginning of the game and the overtime period, and games will be started with a kickoff by the winning team. Kickoffs will also start play, by the opposing team, after a goal is scored.

Substitutions can be made throughout the game.

There are no boundaries.

Rules & Violations

If the ball gets stuck in the corner of the gym, a corner kick will be made to initiate play again.

All of the following rules will result in a turn over. The ball will be turned over to the opposing team at the point of the violation.

- No hands can be used.
- No clipping.
- No tripping.
- No full body contact (pushing).

If any player tries to defend a goal in the penalty area or stands in the penalty area for more than 3 seconds, a penalty kick will be awarded to the opposite team, with one person from the defending team being able to act as a temporary goalie.
