TRANSFERRING FROM NORTHWESTERN BUSINESS COLLEGE TO AURORA UNIVERSITY

GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS – BACHELOR OF ARTS, BACHELOR OF SCIENCE, BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING, AND BACHELOR OF SOCIAL WORK

Aurora University has a mathematics requirement that may be met by passing a competency examination (with no credit granted toward the degree) or through the completion of NBC's MATH115 General Education Mathematics with a grade of C or higher, or through coursework at Aurora University. Some majors may require additional math coursework at a higher level.

The written communication requirement will be satisfied by C150 and 200.

Associate Degrees - - If you have completed an A.A or an A.S. degree, you may have met all lower-division general education requirements. Aurora University requires completion of an approved 3000 level general education writing intensive course.

TRANSFER OF CREDIT TO AURORA UNIVERSITY

This Transfer Guide indicates the transferability of the courses offered by Northwestern Business College. Additional guidelines for the overall transfer of credit are as follows:

A maximum of 68 semester hours (102 quarter hours) may be transferred from an accredited two-year institution.

Courses with a grade of C- or higher will transfer provided that they are designated as transferable courses. Courses numbered below the 100 levels will not be transferred.

When you transfer to Aurora University, you will need to have official transcripts of your work at Northwestern Business College and all other colleges/universities you have attended sent to the Admissions Office. The Aurora University Registrar will then make an official evaluation of your transfer work.

HOW TO USE THIS TRANSFER GUIDE:

At the top of each column of courses, you will see the following notations. Their definitions are:

1. Course number and title: The NBC course number and title according to the 2006/2008 catalog.
2. QH: The number of quarter hours awarded for the course at NBC.
3. The A.U. course equivalent: Either a specific course or an elective.
4. GER: Indicates how the course may be applied toward general education requirements: APA and APB = Aesthetic and Philosophical Expression, KOA and KOB = Knowing Ourselves and Others, ONW = Observation of the Natural World.
5. Comments: Comments regarding specific transfer regulations.

Some courses are transferable, but cannot be used in a major or to meet general education degree requirements. This coursework may be used as general elective credit to help complete the minimum 120 semester hours required for graduation.

Cross-listed courses will be transferred from the department in which they were taken.
