**MCC nursing classes do not directly transfer to AU. Instead, AU will grant students 40 semester hours of block credit for having their RN license.*

Students must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA, an Associate's Degree in Nursing, an active unencumbered Illinois RN license, and a letter of reference from a supervisor or a former faculty to be eligible for admittance to the Aurora University School of Nursing. To graduate with their BSN, students must complete at least 120 credits of coursework with a GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
