Prostitution Investigations Policy

Notice of Policy Update

Aurora University Campus Public Safety routinely reviews and updates internal policies and procedures to ensure compliance with Illinois law and best practices in campus policing.

New Policy on Prostitution Investigations

Effective Date: July 1, 2025

Aurora University Campus Public Safety does not conduct prostitution investigations and have an agreement with the City of Aurora that any felony investigation related to prostitution is referred to the Aurora Police Department.

In addition, in accordance with Illinois law (5 ILCS 812/10), Campus Public Safety officers are prohibited from knowingly and willingly engaging in any act of sexual penetration with a suspect during the course of any law enforcement investigation.

Illinois Statute: 5 ILCS 812/10

Sec. 10. Law enforcement agency policy; prostitution investigations. Each law enforcement agency shall create and publicly post a policy prohibiting officers from knowingly and willingly performing an act of sexual penetration with the suspect of a criminal investigation of prostitution during the course of an investigation conducted by that officer.
